

Protocol

for unimpeded transit of foreign nationals through the territory of
the Republic of North Macedonia

1. Until the final liberalization of the regime for entry in and exit from the territory of the Republic of North Macedonia, foreign nationals may use the following border crossing points for transiting through the territory of the Republic of North Macedonia: Tabanovce, Deve Bair, Bogorodica, Kjafasan, Blace and the Border Crossing Point at the Skopje Airport.
2. Transit shall mean entry at a border crossing point and exit from another border crossing point, referred to in Item 1 of this Protocol, while in the course of transit foreign nationals are not allowed to deviate from the designated motorways or regional roads and the transit shall be completed within 5 hours.
3. Foreign nationals transiting through the territory of the Republic of North Macedonia may avail themselves of the facilities at gas stations along their route, being under the obligation to respect all protocols prescribed by the Ministry of Health applied with a view to prevent the introduction and spread of the COVID-10 virus and all duties set forth under said Protocols. Companies owning gas stations are under the obligation to implement enhanced controls and supervision of the implementation of and respect for relevant protective and preventive measures.
4. With a view to facilitating unimpeded transit, the herewith enclosed Statement is hereby introduced, which foreign nationals are to fill in and sign upon entry in the territory of the Republic of North Macedonia; the filled in and signed Statement shall be certified by the border police and foreign nationals shall present such signed and certified Statement to the border police upon exit from the territory of the Republic of North Macedonia, in order that the border police examine and control and duration of the transit.
5. The consequence for foreign nationals transiting through the territory of the Republic of North Macedonia for the non-fulfilment of the rule under Item 4 of this Protocol, may be their referral to compulsory state quarantine, in order for their health status to be checked and verified.
6. Upon the entry into force of this Protocol, the obligation of foreign nationals to register their transit via diplomatic missions and consular posts of their respective countries, as a condition for the transit to be approved, shall cease to apply.
